### Online Protocols, Expectations and Confidentiality

Google Hangouts are an essential element of our remote learning program and delivery. There are a few items that I need to remind parents and students about:

- <u>Total confidentiality is assumed and expected.</u> It is a great opportunity to strengthen our home/school learning partnership by having parents present in the background during hangouts but this also will result in parents accessing information about other students' learning. This is to be kept strictly confidential.
- <u>Parental supervision is expected and required</u>. We are assuming that as parents, you have approved your child's participation in the hangouts and will be there somewhere in the background. For very small group or the occasional one on one hangout, due to child safety reasons, we expect parents to be present at all times.
- <u>Hangouts are usually for students only.</u> Please refrain from adding comments to student hangouts. While the teachers and Learning Support Officers would love to have a chat with parents, as you can imagine, we are very time poor and other students may not take your comments or input as you intended.
- Hangouts, email and other communication that is school based or facilitated through school login is to be used for school learning purposes only. This is a reminder for all students to keep learning as the focus when using our school-based facilities and connections.
- <u>User Agreement reminders</u> Please remember that students are bound by their SJV User Agreement and are expected to be smart, safe, responsible and respectful at all times.
