Dear Families,

Last week was probably our best week at school this year. It was so heart-warming to hear the laughter, squeals and banter out in the playground.

Thank you, parents, for your support of our COVID safe procedures in ensuring there are no gatherings at the school gates and staggered dismissal times. The intention of allocating specific gates for entering and exiting the school is to create the best possible environment for reducing the risk of the virus spreading. If for some reason you need to change the gate your family uses, please speak with the teacher on duty and this will be fine.

There are a number of other measures we have in place to create a COVID safe culture and environment. Some are imposed by the government, some are recommended and others are facilitated by us. We understand that not all procedures will suit every family but as a package, they are all designed to keep our staff, students and families safe. Here are some of the measures we currently have in place:

- No singing
- Keep rooms ventilated (open windows)
- No birthday treats to be handed out at school
- Students lining up in different areas
- Students playing in different areas on a roster system to keep year levels separated
- Promoting good practices - e.g. washing hands
- Providing hand sanitiser in all learning areas
- Planning modified programs and events to work in with restrictions
- Taking temperatures each morning

## **Traffic and Road Safety**

Child safety is our main concern during drop off and pick up times. By following these simple procedures and guidelines we can all work together to ensure all children are kept safe.

- Please be patient and courteous towards all other road users
- Please cross the road at the School Crossing.
- Remember to leave the bus bay clear until passengers have boarded the bus and it has departed
- Please do not park in the drop off zone for long periods of time- Kiss and Drop!
- Please read all council parking signs carefully (parking inspectors have been patrolling the area and you will be fined)
- Please remember that little legs cannot be seen between parked cars. Do not call students over when parked on the opposite side of the road.

*We have a teacher overseeing students crossing at the unmanned pedestrian crossing in Frank Street to keep our children safe. Please work with them to teach our children good practices, such as waiting until the signal is given to cross safely and walking between the lines.*
